

**DPSFC RULES COMMITTEE PROPOSED RULES CHANGES
SANTA FE COUNTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING APRIL 28, 2018**

Background

In order to maintain and support the increased workload of the DPSFC Platform Committee, it is being proposed to increase the membership size of the Platform Committee.

Summary

The primary rule change is proposed to:

Revise DPSFC Rule 6-B-1.a to increase the size of Platform Committee membership from seven members to twelve members.

Intent

The intent of the rule change is to:

- Engage more party members in leadership roles
- Increase productivity by spreading the workload among more party members
- Engage a more diverse committee that is representative of a cross-section of the County

Rule 6-B-1.a Platform and Resolutions Committee

DPSFC Rule 6-B-1.a is hereby amended as follows:

6-B-1.a The County Chairperson shall appoint twelve members from recommendations submitted by Ward Coordinators. The members shall be appointed so as to be representative of a cross-section of the County, but need not be members of the County Central Committee.
