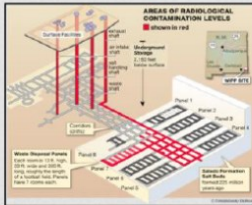
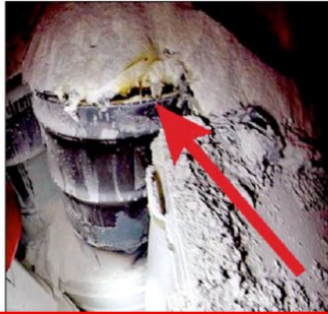


# Valentine's Day, 2014 WIPP Explosion

**12:45** -outside the East (main) Entrance for songs of satire that tell the story of the how kitty litter caused the explosion

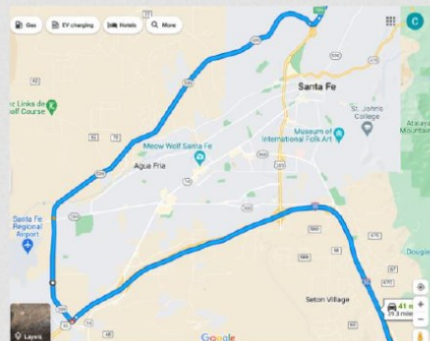
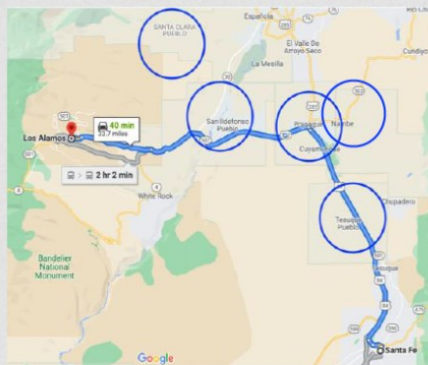
**1:00** -move inside the Rotunda for demonstration of how many neighborhoods are at risk from transportation of radioactive waste
