CSP volunteers continued working with most of our partner organizations the first quarter of 2023. Volunteers collected garbage monthly at the Villa Linda Park and in the neighboring arroyo. At one event, volunteers found a cumulative seven dollars—bonus!

Volunteers worked at the Food Depot prepping food for distribution by sorting potatoes, onions and packing pantry bags. CSP Volunteers for the Food Depot have proved themselves so efficient at packing pantry bags that Food Depot personnel, if able, schedule pantry bags when CSP volunteers are scheduled to work.

The Wednesday Kitchen Angels team continued to delver meals on Wednesday's and a Monday team received training and completed their first meals delivery on March 27th.

Activities with Habitat for Humanity picked up again on the 4th Saturday of every month helping with construction of new home. The current build site is 1501 Calle Preciosa and is adobe construction. Volunteers have assisted with stacking adobes, sifting dirt to make mortar for adobe walls, putting up a header beam for a garage door, and other construction duties.

Volunteers continued working with animals this past winter, even when the weather may not have seemed optimal. Training for new shelter volunteers is available upon request.
